Boat Rental Terms & Conditions

The renter agrees:

1. To operate the boat in DAYLIGHT hours only.
2. To dock, anchor, or secure the boat and equipment to prevent damage to boat, motor, equipment and/or dock, boats, and persons as result of existing or changing weather conditions.
3. To pay the appropriate service charges for any service required as a result of his/her carelessness or neglect in respect to the boat.
4. To return the boat in the same condition as when first rented, and to reimburse the Owner for the cost of repairs and service in respect of any and all damages.
5. To be responsible for any legal costs or expenses connected with the collection of any debts incurred by reason of any damage to boat during the time of rental.
6. Any and all Federal, State and Local Laws and Ordinances must be adhered to. (I.e. Transport Canada)
7. Renter must be Present for check-out and check-in on all Boat Rentals.
8. Designated drivers must be present and sign responsibility for the watercraft.
9. Boats are checked out and in during daylight hours.
10. We reserve the right to refuse service.
11. That he/she is over the age of 25 and has no medical conditions that could affect his/her ability to operate the vessel safely.
12. MasterCard, Visa or Cash accepted. (Credit Card holder must be present.)
13. Life preservers are provided at no additional charge.
14. Boat safety is strictly enforced by the owner of the boat. (There is 8 person capacity limit - all persons must wear life preservers at all times)
15. Boat is only rented after safety protocols have been explained to renter(s) as per Transport Canada regulations and guidelines
16. Renter(s) are fully responsible for guest(s) on the boat. Passengers must be fully disclosed to the Ltd Enterprises Inc. staff member.
17. That the rental cost of the boat DOES NOT include gas or applicable taxes.
18. Not to tow another craft, or engage in any act that involves pulling or towing a vessel, and/or object.
19. Boats returned late are subject to additional charges.
20. That animals are not permitted on our boats.
21. The renter must have a working cell phone on board and accessible at all times during rental.

Failure to comply with any of these policies may result in immediate termination of boat rental and forfeiture of all or part of monies promised or paid by renter.

Insurance

It is understood that the renter will be totally responsible for all damages to any boat, motor and equipment that they have rented regardless of fault. It is also understood that a renter's automobile insurance in Canada will not cover the boat. Ltd Enterprises Inc. carries public liability on our rental boats. Individuals will be responsible for any damage incurred while the boat is in their care, custody or control. Furthermore, no alcohol is allowed on our boats.

Cancellation Policy

You will need to hold your reservation with a \$500 DEPOSIT. The full rental price must be paid in full 48 hours prior to departure. If you cancel less than 48 hours before check-in date, there will be no refunds. No exceptions. A charge equal to your complete confirmed reservation will be made for failure to cancel before check-in date. In other words, if you do not cancel prior to the arrival date of your confirmed reservation, you will be charged full price unless we are able to rebook your reservation dates.

Damage Deposit

Your damage deposit of \$1500 will be held until the end of your trip at which time it will be refunded to you in full, less the fuel you use. If there is damage to the prop, boat, lost, broken, or damaged inventory items, late returns, excessively unclean boats, a substantial noise complaint or any damage resulting from negligent or irresponsible operation of or activity on the boat, outstanding charges will then apply. The boat is sent out with a full tank of fuel and upon return usage is calculated at \$35 per ¼ tank by a staff member. Charges for refueling will be deducted from your damage deposit along with any other outstanding charges and the balance will be refunded to you. Renter agrees that all damage will be charged at \$150/hr labour plus materials cost.
